## **Important Notes**



- You belong to the faculty of Business & Economics (Wirtschaftswissenschaften)
- Standard time of study: 4 Semesters
  - Winter semester: 1.10. 31.03.
  - Summer semester: 01.04. 30.09.
- Exams usually take place in February/March and July until September
- Modules usually don't require your attendance
  - Individual responsibility!

- Master program consists of 120 ECTS
  - 30 ECTS per semester if you stay in the standard period of study


### IMPORTANT:




# How to apply for courses

In HIS-LSF



- Please open HIS LSF
- Log in using you uni-user-identification
- Select correct semester
- Click "courses" and then "course overview"
- Select faculty of Business and Economics






- Select a type of Module, e.g. Electives in Business Administration
- Then choose the course you want to apply for
- Pay attention here, Economics students are only allowed to choose 8 ECTS outside of the VWL area.








If you click here, you can see general information on the course like schedule, professor, whether and when there is a tutorial, room...







- Your done with the course application!
- Usually, after a couple of days you will receive access to the course folder in Ilias
- Repeat this process for all courses you want to take

### Exams



- Please be aware of deadlines for exam registration
  - Registration via Student's portal
  - Registration period usually 2-3 Weeks in May and December
  - Afterwards, there is NO registration possible!!!
- Withdrawal of registration up until 7 days previous to exam without having to give explanations
  - Afterwards, an attestation will be required
  - If you do not withdraw from an elective module 7 days before, you HAVE TO complete the module
- You have three attempts to pass each course, if you fail three times you'll be exmatriculated
  - Usually one exam date per semester
  - 2 dates per semester for elective modules, but only in semesters where the course is offered!
  - If you fail the second time, the third attempt must be within 15 months after second
